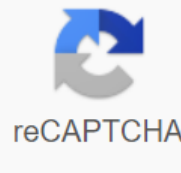

## Amazon kindle manual software update

If you want the latest Kindle features right to the latter (or missed a past update), the best way to get an instant update for your Kindle is to do so manually. Read on as we show you how easy it is to update your Kindle. As a general rule, Amazon over-the-air updates are usually hiccup free (even if they can take more than a month to slowly roll over to any Kindle around the world). But maybe your Kindle has stopped updating for no reason (like ours), or maybe you're just in a hurry to get the latest and best features. Whatever the reasons, you don't have to wait for Amazon to deploy this update. Step One: Identify your Kindle model Although we will update the second generation Kindle Paperwhite in this tutorial, the same technique will guide you through the work on all the different Kindle models. The first and most important step is that you can identify the Kindle you have to ensure that you compare the right version of the software for your model and download the appropriate update. Instead of squinting at the tiny model number on the back of the case and then google the model number, the easiest method is to check the serial number as the first four alphanumeric characters indicate the model/Kindle generation. RELATED: How to Jailbreak Your Kindle Paperwhite for screensavers, apps, and more If your Kindle is connected to your Amazon account, just sign in to Amazon content and devices on your dashboard and click on your devices tab. Select the Kindle you want to update and read the notation next to it as this: In the case of the Kindle I'm interested in updating today, the first four characters of the serial number are B0D4. You can also find the serial number by turning on the Kindle and looking at the Settings menu &gt; device information. After you get the first four characters, you can refer to the following list to determine which model you want. Save yourself some time and use Ctrl+F to search for a string. Kindle 1 (2007): B000 Kindle 2 (2009): B002, B003 Kindle DX (2010: B004, B005, B009 Kindle Keyboard (2010): B006, B008, B00A Kindle 4 (2011): B00E, B023, B023 Kindle Touch (2012): B00F, B010, B011, B012 Kindle Paperwhite 1 (2012): B024, B01B, B01C, B01D, B01F, B020 Kindle Paperwhite 2 (2013): B0D4, B0D4, B0D5, B0D5, B0D6, B0D6, B0D7, B0D7, B0D8, B0D8, B0F2, B0F2, B017, B017, B060, B060, B062, B062, B05F, B05F, B05F, B05F, B05F Kindle 7 (2014): B001, B0C6, B0C6, B0D0, B0D0, B0D0, B0D0, B013, B053, B054 Kindle Paperwhite 3 (2015): G090 Kindle Oasis (2016): G0B0 Kindle 8 (2016): B018 After double checking the serial number on the list, it's time to download the actual update files. Step two: Download the kindle version number update - in our case, confirmed by serial number, Paperwhite 2, go to Amazon Fire & Kindle Software Updates. Scroll down until you reach the Kindle section, then match the Kindle you have with the right model. Remember Remember there can be multiple versions of the same model, so in the first step we looked for a serial number. When you select a model, you'll see a download link with the current version number in the list. Make a note of the version number, but don't download it yet. Before downloading the update, make sure that the version number is higher than the current version on your Kindle. In the Kindle app, go to Menu &gt; Settings &gt; menu &gt; device information. You'll see a screen similar to the following. Of course, the firmware version we have on our Paperwhite (5.6.1) is behind the latest version of this writing (5.8.5). Somewhere along the line, we got the summer update 2016, but we missed the great autumn update 2016 that ushered in a new home screen layout. Now, with discrepancies between the latest version and our confirmed version, we can download the update file. Click on the Download software update [version number] link. Saves the update as a .bin file. Step three: Copy the update to the Kindle and install it when the download is complete, attach the Kindle Paperwhite to your computer using a USB cable, and copy the update. BIN to the root of the Kindle Paperwhite. The file must be in the top-level folder, so if your computer mounts the Kindle as drive F, the path to the managed update package should be F:\update\_kindle\_[version number].bin After placing the file in the root of your Kindle device, right-click on the Kindle drive and select eject to uninstall it from your system. Go ahead and unplug it. Now, you just need to instruct the Kindle to update through kindle's menu system. In the kindle, go to the settings menu &gt; to enter the settings menu, then press the Menu button again from the settings menu and select Update kindle. Press OK, and then wait. (If the Update your kindle option is grayed out, it means that kindle was unable to locate the .bin file, make sure you put it in the root and try again.) After restarting the Kindle (don't worry if it takes a minute or more to finish restarting and updating), repeat the version check process by looking at the Device Information menu. You should see the updated version number, and for newer versions of Kindle operating systems, you can even read the version information directly on your device by tapping the More Info button. Your Kindle is now up to date with the latest features and you don't have to wait for your device to automatically update on the air. While we hope your future OTA updates are smoother, it's easy (when you know where to look) to manually download the update and refresh your Kindle to the latest version. You can download several books in your readers and at any time wait or have the need to rest, e-books are ready. Kindle e-readers make it convenient for readers to access their favorite books without carrying a huge mass. However, to improve the performance of your e-reader, software updates are available to add more features to your device. These free updates are improvements made by Amazon and may even include fixes for bugs and issues in previous versions. Software updates on Kindle e-readers are automatically downloaded and installed on your device. However, if you think you missed the update and feel the need to manually download and install software updates, you can follow these steps. How to update software or firmware on kindle E-Reader manually To update the firmware on a Kindle electronic reader to the latest version, use your computer to download the software installer. Make sure you have a good internet connection to properly download updates. In your computer browser using any browser, go to the know the kindle model of electronic reader you are using. On the website, you will see a list of Kindle models. Look for the device model. On the right, click Download software update. If you want to learn more about the software update you downloaded, choose View version information. You'll find the update version and release date. You'll also see the features and improvements you'll get when you install the version. After downloading the file, turn on your Kindle device. Use the Kindle charging cable to connect your Kindle to your computer. Open the Kindle drive. Look for the software update file and drag it to your Kindle drive. Wait for the transfer to complete. Now you can safely eject your Kindle from your computer and unplug the charging cable. On the Kindle E-Reader Open the home page. Tap the Menu icon. Choose Settings. Tap the Menu icon again. Select Update your kindle. Press OK to start installing updates. Wait for the process to complete. When you're done, your Kindle e-reader will restart. Now connect the device for charging. Let it charge you overnight to index books. Note: Amazon has ended support for the 7th generation Kindle Paperwhite 3. It was one of Amazon's most successful e-readers. The last working firmware version on this device is 5.12.2. Installing software updates to your Kindle will make it more efficient and work better. Was the article helpful?
